About the project

The City of Stonnington has commenced the redevelopment of the Como Park Oval. The works include removing the old turf, installing a new irrigation drainage system and laying drought tolerant Santa Ana turf.

To improve safety, we are also resizing the two existing turf cricket wickets.

We recognise works of the nature will cause some inconvenience. Every effort will be made to keep disruption to a minimum and we thank you in advance for your patience and understanding.

The Como Park oval redevelopment supports the city's ongoing commitment to delivering safe and functional open spaces and sporting fields for the community to enjoy.

- » New irrigation system
- » Resize two turf cricket wickets
- » Reinstate turf
