- New fencing along Canterbury Road
- Park lighting
- More seating and a drinking fountain with 'dog bowl'
- An expanded BBQ area
- Bluestone and concrete paved entrance from Canterbury Road
- Upgraded path through Fairbairn Reserve
- Additional garden bed planting

The initial stage of these upgrades will commence in August 2020 and will include the shelter, BBQ, seating and drinking fountain.

The remaining works, including new paths, fencing, lighting and planting are scheduled to be delivered towards the end of 2020.


