The City of Stonnington wishes to advise residents and park users of the upcoming construction works within Princes Gardens, Prahran. These works are scheduled to commence **Monday 28 September 2020.**

The works will be undertaken by Citywide Service Solutions Pty Ltd and form part of the next stage of delivery of the Princes Gardens Masterplan. Specifically, these works include:

- new paths between Little Chapel Street and Essex Street
- new lighting
- new picnic area with shelters, bbqs & picnic tables
- new park furniture
- removal of one tree
- new irrigation, garden beds and tree planting
- Regrading of the sunken oval

Construction is programmed to be completed by January 2021 and will be carried out between the hours of 7:00am and 5:00pm Monday to Friday and 8:00am and 5:00pm on Saturdays if required.

Pedestrian access through the southern areas of the park will be restricted during construction, however appropriate detours will be in place.

The contractor Citywide Service Solutions Pty Ltd and the City of Stonnington will endeavour to minimise disruption at all times.


FAQ:

Q. Will 'Pedestrian Access' be affected?

A. Yes. Pedestrian access through the southern section of the park, including the sunken oval area will be restricted during construction. However, access along the central North/South pathway will remain open during the works.

Q. Will 'Vehicle Access' be affected?

A. No. Vehicle access will be maintained on Princes Close and Essex Street. Three car spaces on Essex Street will be required for access. Traffic control personnel will be present to manage vehicles when required.
