- 1 Entry points to Thomas Oval from Como Park North to include a paved space, waste amenities, directional signage and regulatory signage.
 - 2 Entry points to dog park.
 - 3 Quiet area fencing.
 - 4 Large open lawn area.
 - 5 Dogs on-leash zone with existing picnic area.
 - 6 Relocated fitness equipment and perimeter path.
 - 7 Signage at Thomas Oval entries to assist in wayfinding.
- Perimeter fencing of dog park.








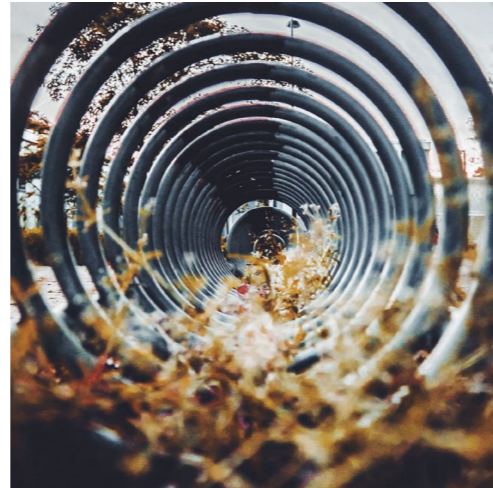
