Family violence

In 2020, the number of family violence incidents reported to police increased **a** by 24% to 1040.

70%

of family violence incidents reported to police were **between** current or former partners.



In 70%

of family violence cases in Stonnington. females were affected. Those aged 25-34 are the largest age group affected.



The most frequent type of abuse/violence reported was verbal abuse followed by emotional abuse and physical abuse.

Family violence is the leading driver of homelessness for women.

88.6%

took place at a residential location. Children were present at 14.1% of incidents.



of calls to the Seniors **Rights Victoria Helpline** are from women and 28% are from men.



Gender and health

27,2%

of residents have low levels of support for gender equality.

In 2020, approximately 3 out of every 4 suicides were males. Those aged 25-34 years were the largest age group for suicides.









Hospital admissions for falls is higher in Stonnington than Greater Melbourne and Victoria.



During COVID-19 restrictions:

Women were more likely than men to have experienced high or very high levels of psychological distress.



There was an increase in **elder abuse incidents**.
