## Instrument of Delegation by CEO for VicSmart Applications under the *Planning and Environment Act 1987*

In exercise of the power conferred by section 98(2) of the *Local Government Act 1989* and section 188 of the *Planning and Environment Act 1987*, I, as Chief Executive Officer of Stonnington City Council and the responsible authority for the administration and enforcement of the Stonnington Planning Scheme as set out in clause 72.01 of that scheme, by this instrument of delegation:


3. declare that this Instrument of Delegation:
