Proposal to implement a trial one-way flow arrangement in Grattan Street, Prahran

The City of Stonnington gives notice that under the provisions of S207, Schedule 11 Clause 10 (1)(c) of the *Local Government Act 1989*, it proposes to implement on a trial basis, a one-way flow arrangement in Grattan Street, Prahran.

The City of Stonnington is proposing to conduct a twelve month trial of southbound one-way flow between Commercial Road and Greville Street. The one-way flow arrangement will be supported by signage and temporary kerbing as required. A concept sketch of the proposed arrangement is shown in the diagram.

Submissions are now invited in accordance with the provisions of S223 of the *Local Government Act 1989*. Any persons wishing to make a submission on the proposal, must forward it in writing to the Transport and Parking Manager, PO Box 58, Malvern 3144, or via email to council@stonnington.vic.gov.au, or deliver to the Stonnington Corporate Centre at the corner of High Street and Glenferrie Road, Malvern, prior to the close of business on 7 February 2020.

Any person making a submission is entitled to state in the submission that he or she wishes to appear in person, or to be represented by a person specified in the submission, at a meeting to be heard in support of the submission.

Please note that copies of submissions (including submitters' names and addresses) will be made available at the Council or special committee meeting at which the above proposal will be considered. The Council is also required to make submissions available for public inspection for a period of 12 months.

All submitters will be given at least 14 days written notice of the date, time and place of the meeting of Council, or a Committee of Council, convened to hear submissions.
