

Prahran Market Facade Restoration

Facade and roof remediation works

About the project

The City of Stonnington has teamed with Prahran Market to restore the market building and infrastructure on Commercial Road in South Yarra.

From August 2023, remediation of the facade and roof will start.

We recognise works of the nature will cause some inconvenience. Every effort will be made to keep disruption to a minimum and we thank you in advance for your patience and understanding.

NO access restrictions to any Prahran Market shops and the Market will trade as usual in terms of operating hours.



Works

- » Erect scaffolding on Commercial Road and inside the Market from August 2023 to early March 2024
- » Replace existing roof slates
- » Repair damaged section of roof structure
- » Repair doors and windows
- » Strengthen building structure
- » Repair and paint façade
- » Upgrade air conditioning system in the facade section of the building
- » Renew walkways within the ceiling and upgrade roof



When

August 2023 to March 2024
6am to 6pm (Monday to Saturday)



Resident

During working hours, Commercial Road and Market Street may occasionally be impacted by vehicles loading and unloading materials, however the impact will be minimal.



Motorists

During working hours all roads will remain open and the impact on the traffic will be minimal.



Pedestrians

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times. Some areas of the footpath will be affected by scaffolding and site hoarding. Detours will be in place.
