

# Prahran Market Substation Upgrade

## Substation and power upgrade

### About the project

The City of Stonnington has teamed with Prahran Market to restore the market building and infrastructure.

From January 2024, substation upgrade work in Market Street will commence.

There will be no access restrictions to any Prahran Market shops, and the market will trade as usual in terms of operating hours.

We recognise works of the nature will cause some inconvenience. Every effort will be made to keep disruption to a minimum and we thank you in advance for your patience and understanding.



### Works

- » Expansion and construction of the substation room
- » Construction and installation of a new switchboard room
- » Increase the power within the market



### Resident

During working hours, Market Street may occasionally be impacted by vehicles loading and unloading materials, however, the impact will be minimal.



### Pedestrians

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times. Some areas of the footpath will be affected by site hoarding. Detours will be in place.
