The City of Stonnington will shortly commence construction of a new park at 17 William Street, South Yarra - adjacent to Lover's Walk and South Yarra Siding Reserve.

The park construction follows a 2024 consultation when we asked the community for their views on concept designs for the new park. What we learned from the positive response has helped us refine the design to deliver a park that reflects the wants and needs of the community who will use it most.

Developing the new park supports our ongoing commitment to create more areas of green space across the city and to deliver quality public spaces for the community to enjoy.

We recognise works of this nature will cause some inconvenience. Every effort will be made to keep disruption to a minimum and we thank you in advance for your patience and understanding.
