Extension of time requests

In accordance with Section 69 of the Planning and Environment Act 1987 a permit can be extended:

Before the permit expires or within 6 months afterwards, the owner or the occupier of the land to which it applies, or another person with the written consent of the owner, may ask the responsible authority for an extension of time.

The owner or occupier of land to which a permit for a development applies, or another person with the written consent of the owner, may ask the responsible authority for an extension of time to complete the development or a stage of the development if—

- (a) the request for an extension of time is made within 12 months after the permit expires; and
- (b) the development or stage started lawfully before the permit expired.

Council's preferred lodgement method is online via the <u>ePlanning Portal</u>. Alternatively, applications can be lodged in person at the Planning Counter at 311 Glenferrie Road, Malvern, emailed to <u>council@stonnington.vic.gov.au</u> or sent via post to Statutory Planning PO Box 53 Malvern 3144.
