Inclusive Game On Indoor sports event

Stonnington Sports Centre Margaret Connellan Stadium





I am going to Stonnington Sports Centre to attend the Inclusive Game On indoor sports day.



I enter the sports centre through wide automatic sliding doors. I may hear the doors opening and closing.



When I enter, I will see people at the front desk who work at the stadium. They are called staff. I can ask them questions if I need help.



The sports centre foyer has public toilets and change rooms that I can use. There are hand dryers in the toilets and change rooms. They can be noisy. I may hear toilets flushing and water running.



I can get water from the water fountain.



There is a café I can get food from.



The sports event will take place in Margaret Connellan Stadium. I can get to the stadium entrance by ramp or stairs.



I enter the sports stadium through wide doors that push open. I may hear the doors opening and closing.



In the sports stadium I may see children and adults. It can be noisy in the stadium. I may hear people talking, cheering and clapping, and balls bouncing. That is okay, they are having fun.



If it is too noisy, I can use my ear defenders, ear plugs or earmuffs.



There is a quiet room that I can go to if I need to take a break. I can ask a staff member to show me where the room is.



I can put my bag or drink bottle on a bench or on the floor outside of the playing area of the courts.



There will be three sports set up that I can play:

- Basketball
- Wheelchair rugby
- Sitting volleyball
- I can try each sport.



There will be volunteers on each court that will be providing guidance about each sport. They can help me with questions. I will listen to their instructions.



There may be others playing with the balls. That is okay. I will wait my turn. Waiting is a fair thing to do.



There will be tables with information flyers that I can get more about the sports I tried.



I can shake hands or say goodbye to volunteers and participants when I am leaving the event. Playing sport is fun.
