Is this a free event?

Pets in the Park is day long free event, everyone is welcome to come down and enjoy the program that celebrates responsible pet ownership of pet. There will be pet competitions, animal demonstrations, expert presentations and much more.

How can I get to Central Park?

We strongly recommend walking, riding or using public transport to get to Central Park. Tram Route 5 (Melbourne University to East Malvern) takes you to Central Park at Stop #52 (end of the line). If you do drive to the event on-street parking is available but spaces are limited, please allow plenty of time to find a parking space. We strongly encourage alternatives methods of transport as there is very limited parking at this event.

Is this event accessible?

Will there be drinking water available?

Bring your reusable water bottle and make use of the water bottle refill station.

Will there be food to purchase?

There will be food vendors at the event offering a range of refreshments and cuisines for purchase.

Can I bring my dog/pet?

Sure can, however pets should be on leash and suitably restrained as per Section 26 of the Domestic Animal Act. All owners are responsible for picking up after their pet.

Can I smoke at the event?

Smoking is not permitted throughout the event site, as per the October 2016 amendment to the Tobacco Act 1987.

Can I buy alcohol at the event?

This is an alcohol free, family friendly event. Alcohol will not be available to purchase at the event.

What happens if I lose my child?

Upon arrival please register your child at the City of Stonnington's Information tent which will enable our Customer Service staff to assist in the unlikely scenario that your child gets lost.

Can I set up a stall or sell at the event?

No. Neither stallholders nor hawkers are permitted at the event.
