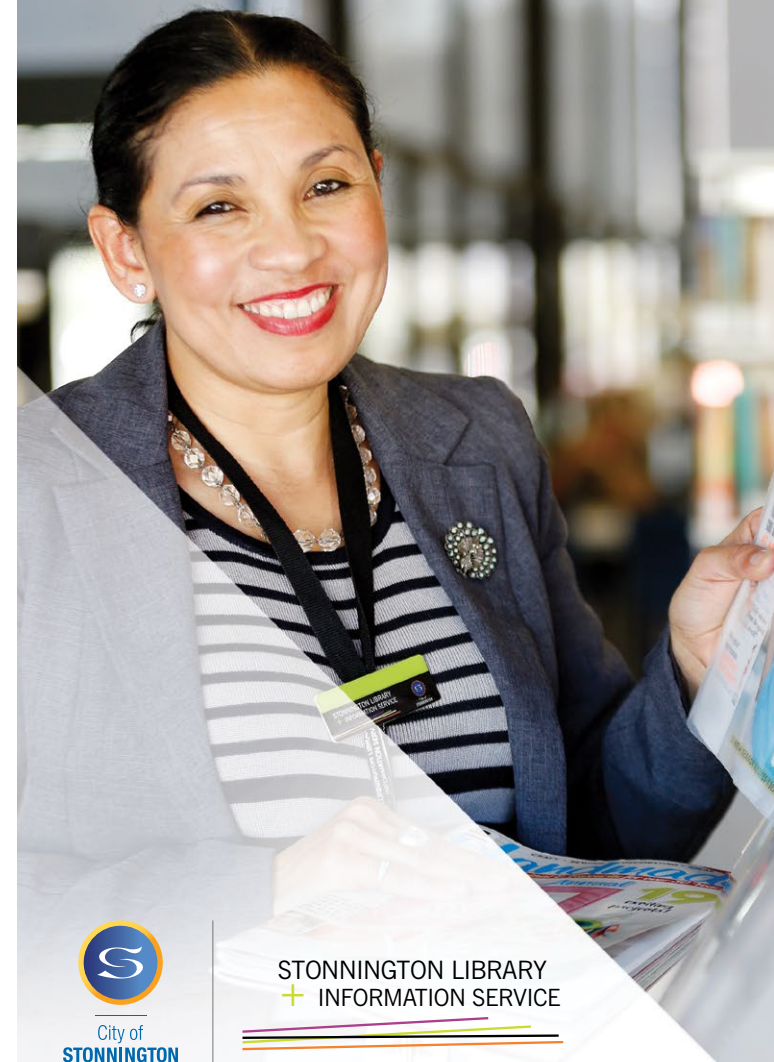

Borrowing

You may borrow up to 50 items for a period of three weeks. Items in high demand have two week loans. All items may be renewed twice if they haven't been reserved by others; this can be done online, in person or by phone.

Items that are on loan or at another library may be reserved. You may reserve up to 20 items and will be notified when they become available.

Items can be returned to any Stonnington Library, and via the after-hours return chutes.

Overdue items incur overdue charges. Provide us with your email address to receive email reminders before your items are due.

Resources

Our collections are wide and varied with items to borrow, download and stream. From recreational reading to learning resources in print and electronic formats, there's something for everyone to enjoy. Search our catalogue or visit our website for:

Access

We aim to be accessible to all members of our community. Our libraries have ramp entry, lifts, hearing loops, recharge points, collections in large print and audio formats, reading aids such as magnifying glasses and some adaptive technology.

Conditions of use

On joining the library you agree to the following conditions:

- > present your library card each time you borrow.
- > accept responsibility for all items borrowed on your library card until returned to the library and processed by staff.
- > as a guarantor, accept responsibility for the choice of items borrowed and for use made of the internet and video games by persons under 18.
- > pay replacement and processing costs for any item(s) lost, destroyed or damaged while on loan, apart from damage by reasonable wear and tear.
- > notify the library immediately if your library card is lost or stolen.
- > notify the library of any change in your personal details, such as name and/or address, and
- > abide by the City of Stonnington Local Laws 2008.

Any personal information collected or obtained from library users will not be used for any other purpose, other than for the provision, review or improvement of library services.
