## **Competition summary**

What's Your Story? is a writing competition presented by Stonnington Libraries as part of the annual literary festival, [untitled]: our writers, readers and stories.

Works can be fiction or non-fiction and based on any theme, however must be original and previously unpublished at the time of entry.

Prizes are awarded for Short Story, Poetry and Creative Writing. To enter the short story and poetry categories you need to be 18 years or over and living in Victoria, while young people aged 5 to 17 years, who live, go to school or work in Stonnington, are invited to enter one of three creative writing categories.

You can enter more than one category if applicable however there is a maximum of one entry per category. For more information, please refer to the 'Categories and Prizes' section.

#### Poetry - Adult

For: Victorian residents 18+ years Guidelines: Maximum 40 lines

Prize: \$500

#### **Short story – Adult**

For: Victorian residents 18+ years

Guidelines: 1000 word limit

Prize: \$500

#### Creative writing, 5 to 8 years

For: Young people aged 5 to 8 years who live or go to school in Stonnington.

Guidelines: 300 to 500 word limit. The entry can be fiction or inspired by real events

experienced by the author. Prize: \$100 book voucher

#### Creative writing, 9 to 12 years

For: Young people aged 9 to 12 years who live, work or go to school in Stonnington. Guidelines: 500 to 750 word limit. The entry can be fiction or inspired by real events

experienced by the author. Prize: \$200 book voucher

#### Creative writing, 13 to 17 years

For: Young people aged 13 to 17 years who live, work or go to school in Stonnington.

Guidelines: 750 to 900 word limit. The entry can be fiction or inspired by real events

experienced by the author. Prize: \$300 book voucher
