Summary Of The Design Your Own Bookmark Competition

Celebrate Children's Book Council of Australia ('CBCA') Book Week 2023 by designing your own bookmark for the City of Stonnington libraries. The theme for Children's Book Week is **Read, Grow, Inspire**. Use this theme to inspire your bookmark design.

To enter the competition all you have to do is pick up your bookmark design template and entry form from any City of Stonnington Library (locations can be found on our website here:

https://www.stonnington.vic.gov.au/Library/Visit-us) or download and print the bookmark design template and entry form (template and entry form can be found here:

https://www.stonnington.vic.gov.au/Library/Kids/Design-a-Library-Bookmark-Competition).

Once you have completed your bookmark template you can either submit your entry in-person to any City of Stonnington Library or scan your template and form and submit it online here:

One winner will be selected in each of the following age categories: 5 - 8 years, 9 -12 years, 13 - 17 years old. Winners will be notified by 15 September 2023 and the winning designs will be printed onto a bookmark that will be available for free from City of Stonnington Library locations. Terms And Conditions of Entry

- 1. The Design a Stonnington Library Bookmark Competition (the Competition) presents an opportunity for you to show what the CBCA Book Week 2023 theme means to you in a fun and unique way!
- all entries are judged based on their originality, design and how they capture the theme of CBCA Book Week 2023. The Competition (Design Your Own Bookmark Competition) is running from 1 August 2023 to 31 August 2023.
- The Competition is being run and managed by City of Stonnington, 311 Glenferrie Road
 Malvern Victoria 3144 (Proponent).
- Entrance into the Competition is deemed as acceptance of these Terms and Conditions of Entry.
- 5. Failure by the Proponent to enforce any of its rights under these Terms and Conditions of Entry at any stage, does not constitute a waiver of those rights.
- 6. The Proponent may disqualify any entrant deemed to not be complying with the Terms and Conditions of Entry and the Entry Requirements at its discretion.
- 7. Entry to the Competition is achieved by submitting either, in person or uploading, an original, unique and creative bookmark design that represents what the CBCA Bookweek theme means to you in accordance with the below Entry Requirements during the promotional period.
- 8. The Proponent may, at any time, at its discretion, modify these Terms and Conditions, including the Privacy Policy, with notice. Any such modification will be effective immediately upon the Proponent publishing revised versions of the Terms and Conditions of Entry and Privacy Policy on its website dated accordingly. Continued participation in the Competition

following any such modification constitutes your acceptance of the modified Terms and Conditions.

Promotional period

- 9. Entries must be submitted to the Competition during the campaign period from 12:00 a.m. (AEST) on 1 August 2023 to 11:59 p.m. (AEST) on 31 August 2023 (the promotional period).
- 10. One winner per category will be selected and notified on Friday 15 September 2023 and may also be announced on the Proponents website and/or social media channels on or after this date.
- 11. The winners will be notified by Friday 15 September 2023. The winners will be contacted by a representative of the Proponent via an email to the email address nominated on the entry form.

Who can enter

- 12. Save for Clauses 13 to 15 herein, the Competition is open to all individuals. Entrants do not need to be residents of the City of Stonnington.
- 13. City of Stonnington staff, contractors and Councillors are not eligible for entry into the Competition.
- 14. Entrants must fit within one of the applicable entrant categories outlined below:
 - a. 5 to 8 years old category:
 - i. Aged between 5 and 8 years old (inclusive) at the time of entry into the
 Competition; and
 - ii. Reside, either full or part time, within the bounds of the City of Stonnington;or
 - iii. Attend school within the bounds of the City of Stonnington.
 - b. 9 to 12 years old category:
 - i. Aged between 9 and 12 years old (inclusive) at the time of entry into the Competition; and

- ii. Reside, either full or part time, within the bounds of the City of Stonnington;or
- iii. Attend school within the bounds of the City of Stonnington.
- c. 13 to 17 years old category:
 - i. Aged between 13 and 17 years old (inclusive) at the time of entry into the Competition; and
 - ii. Reside, either full or part time, within the bounds of the City of Stonnington;or
 - iii. Attend school within the bounds of the City of Stonnington.
- 15. Individuals under the age of 18 must ensure they have permission from a parent and or legal guardian before submitting their entry.

Entry requirements

- 16. Entry to the Competition is free.
- 17. There is a limit of one (1) entry per person in total throughout the Competition and promotional period.
- 18. The design submitted must be contained on the Bookmark Template provided either in person or downloaded from the proponent's website. The design must be original and not contain any copyrighted material.

19. Entries must:

- a. Be in the form provided by the Proponent and be unique, creative and original and capture the theme of CBCA Book Week 2023;
- b. Not contain any content that: is sexually explicit or suggestive, violent or derogatory, profane or pornographic, involves nudity, promotes alcohol, illegal drugs, tobacco, firearms/weapons; promotes any activities that may appear unsafe or dangerous; promotes any particular political agenda or message; is obscene or offensive; endorses any form of hate or hate group; defames, misrepresents or contains

disparaging remarks about the Proponent or its partners, other companies or people; contains materials embodying the names, likenesses, or other indicia identifying any person, including, without limitation, celebrities, and/or other public or private figure, living or dead, without permission; communicates messages or images inconsistent with positive images and or goodwill; and/or violates any applicable laws.

- c. If any entry contains any content as described in Clause 19.b, and/or is any way deemed obscene or offensive, the Proponent reserves all of its rights to not accept the submission of entry and delete any such obscene or offensive materials.
- 20. All entry details are final at the time of submission of an entry. Entrants are unable to make edits to an entry once an entry has been submitted.
- 21. Entrants are required to retain a copy of any entry submitted either online or in person in the highest resolution possible and provide these upon request by the Proponent.
- 22. Entries may only be submitted either online by submitting them by using the Design a

 Stonnington Library Bookmark Competition Form or submitting the Design a Stonnington

 Library Bookmark Competition Form in person at a City of Stonnington Library location.
- 23. Hard copy or electronic entries received by the Proponent anywhere other than the places outlined above will not be accepted, for lack of compliance with the Competition Entry Requirements.
- 24. Entries submitted as part of the Competition may be displayed by the Proponent online including (without limitation) social media and broadcast media channels. Entries may be edited, amended and/or collated by the Proponent. As a condition of entering the Competition, entrants' consent to having their entries and first name published.
- 25. By entering this competition, all entrants:
 - a. Consent to the Proponent using, editing or modifying their entry to support the
 Proponent promotional material at any time without compensation;

- Warrant that entries submitted are an original work that does not infringe on the copyright, trademark, intellectual property or moral rights of any third party;
- 26. To enter, eligible entrants must submit their entry during the promotional period by either submitting your entry in person to any City of Stonnington Library or submitting it online at the following website Design a Stonnington Library Bookmark Competition Stonnington Libraries.

Winner determination and prize information

- 27. One entry per category will be selected after the promotional period as the winner.
- 28. One entry per category will be selected by a panel of judges from the City of Stonnington.

 The judges will review the entry based on the game of skill principles in accordance with the Competition Terms and Conditions.
- 29. The judges reserve the right not to award a prize if they form the opinion that the entries submitted do not have sufficient merit to warrant a prize.
- 30. An entrant can only win one (1) prize.
- 31. The prizes for the Design a Stonnington Library Bookmark Competition will be as follows:
 - a. 5-8 years old category: Prize pack made up of books and arts supplies worth up to a total value of \$50;
 - b. 9 12 years old category: Prize pack of books and art supplies worth up to a total value of \$75;
 - c. 13 17 years old category: Prize pack of books and art supplies worth up to a total value of \$100.
- 32. The Prize winners will be informed via email to their supplied email address after the completion of the Competition.
- 33. Prizes are not transferable or exchangeable. No compensation will be payable if the winner is unable to use the prize in its form.

- 34. Where a winner of a prize is under the age of 18, their prize will be awarded in the company of their parent or legal guardian.
- 35. The Proponent will not be liable for any loss or damage whatsoever which is suffered (including but not limited to direct or consequential loss) or for any personal injury suffered or sustained in connection with entry to the Competition.
- 36. The Proponent accepts no responsibility for any late, lost, or misdirected entries including delays in submission due to technical disruptions, network congestion or for any other reason.

Privacy – collection notice

37. The City of Stonnington is awarding a prize pet category to a person who enters the Design a Stonnington Library Bookmark Competition. We will collect your name and email address to contact the winner and arrange the delivery of the prize, we may use your first name in any publication of the winning entries on Council websites, social media channels or City of Stonnington Library Notice Board, we will not publish any Personal Information. Your full name and contact details will not be shared with any third parties nor used for any other purposes. If you do not provide your name and email address, you will not be eligible to enter the prize draw.
